The Faculty Hall of Fame distinction is granted by Oklahoma Baptist University to honor former OBU faculty members who were master teachers, making a significant impact on OBU students.

Selection Criteria

- Any emeriti or former full-time faculty member who has had an exemplary teaching career at the University is eligible for the award.
- Any Hall of Fame honoree should have demonstrated a commitment to excellence in teaching.
Aspects of Excellence in Teaching: 1. Teaching (knowledge of the subject matter, ability to communicate, organization and planning, self-criticism and improvement); 2. Interest in Students; 3. Professional Development; 4. Research and Writing; 5. The Life of the Mind; 6. Service to the University; and 7. Christian Faith and Professional Life.
